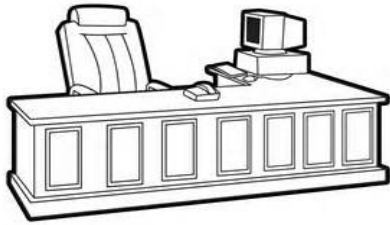

From Fr. JC Maximilian's Desk "Some Things New"

Many pastors will talk about how their parish is the best, but I really think that I have the best parish. As you know, we had our first "First Friday Holy Hour" a little over a week ago. Being that it was something new, and that it started at 5 PM, I did not expect that many people to attend. I thought maybe 10-15 people, and so I only made 20 booklets with the prayers we would be using. I was amazed - and frankly proud - when 40 people attended. OK, we had to share prayer booklets, but everyone participated in praying Evening Prayer, and seemed to get a lot out of the quiet time with our Lord. It was a graced evening. We will have another one of these graced evenings on October 7 - I will make sure to print up some more prayer booklets.

Recognizing how busy some families are, I have decided to pilot a new alternative to our Religious Education program. We will continue to have the Religious Education program that we have been running for the last 8 years, but we are also going to offer to parents who would like to "home-school" their children in religious education, the program My Catholic Faith Delivered. This is an online course of religious education, that encourages parents to work with their children, using a curriculum published by Ignatius Press. Each week children work on a chapter of the curriculum; there is a pre-test and post-test for each chapter, and unit tests. The lessons are not simply reading the material on the computer, but involve videos and other activities. The flexibility of the program will allow students to work on their lessons at a time when they will not be rushed and disturbed by other activities. Our Director of Faith Formation, Pat Brooks, and our Coordinator of Home-School Religious Education (Donna Malinowski has volunteered to do that) will be able to check on each student's progress. Also, all the home-schoolers will meet with me monthly as a group (if we have at least 12 students, with their parents, we will have Mass and then talk about what they learned in the past month). Pat Brooks has developed some policies for how we will use this program in our parish; please see the Faith Formation page in the bulletin. If you are interested, please call her.

Lastly, hopefully by this time you have noticed the new Glory and Praise hymnals, which have our music supplement in the back. These hymnals also have all the readings for all three years of Sunday readings for Mass. Last year, shortly after I arrived, Mike Aub our Music Director and I started to look into the possibility of a hardbound, permanent hymnal. Pope Francis had just published his encyclical on the environment, and the idea of a yearly hymnal just did not seem to be ecologically friendly. OCP which publishes Breaking Bread, the yearly hymnal we have been using for years, also publishes Glory and Praise, which has the vast majority of the songs we have already been using, plus a good number of more contemporary songs. Yes, hardbound hymnals are more expensive, but only in the short term, and given that OCP has given us 0% interest over 5 years, our yearly expense is no more than if we had just ordered the yearly. Actually, somewhere in year 4 we start saving money, and the new hymnals should last us 10 years. Of course, that depends on their not being misused. So please use them respectfully so that we can use them for many years. And of course use them to SING PRAISE TO THE LORD!

Reflect on the Word of Jesus Christ
September 11, 2016
24th Sunday in Ordinary Time
Are you hanging with the wrong crowd!



Jesus was hanging with the people that were lost to him. God will never be outdone in understanding and love! It is to this truth that Jesus directs his parables. We see through the eyes of our frail humanity and all to often we judge one another

harshly. **Realizing how much God loves, forgives and welcomes us, will help us to do the same to each other.**

In the Gospel, the Pharisees complain because Jesus is hanging with the wrong crowd, o my goodness "what sinners"! Then...he eats with them! The Pharisees were appalled.

Jesus tells them two parables about how much God loves. In these parables, he emphasizes how much rejoicing and celebration there is over just one sinner who repents, one sinner who is sorry and promises to be better. God knows us and understands us even when we fall short of being our best self. God constantly seeks us out, inviting us back even when we feel like we do not deserve forgiveness. "Rejoice with me because I have found the coin I lost. All Jesus asks is that we repent and share the "Good News" of Jesus Christ.



Adult: Is there someone you know that is "lost". Ask them out to lunch and ask if they would like to attend Mass with you!

Child: Were you ever lost, even just for a moment. How happy you were to see your Mom and Dad. Jesus feels the same away about you. He does not want you to be lost from him.

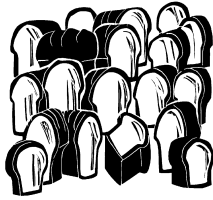

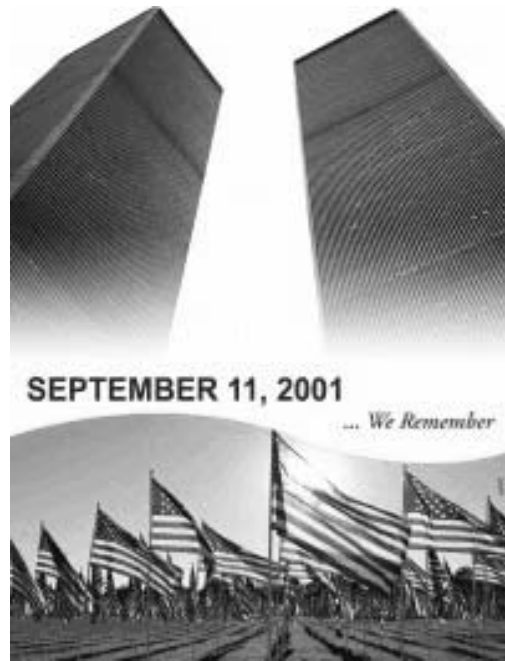

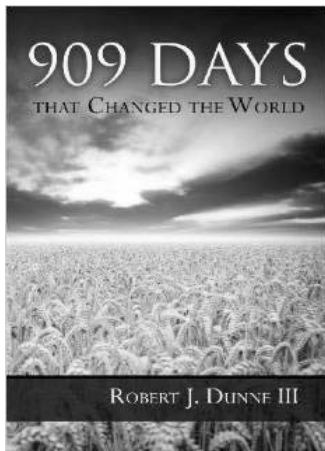


First Friday's Holy Hour

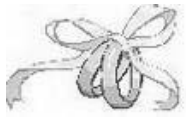
In the Parish Center Foyer

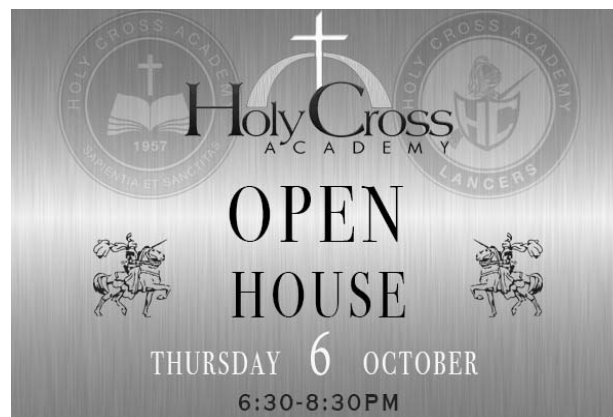
