John 20: 19-31



Although John does not have his own Gospel cycle like the other evangelists, John's Gospel is always read during the Easter season. *In his writings, we find some of the most beautiful and most*

challenging stories. Many of these stories of John help us to believe in Jesus by giving us examples of people who came to believe.

Today is Divine Mercy Sunday, a day to celebrate the love and compassion of God. It is a reminder that no matter what we think or do, God is always ready to forgive us. At the beginning of the Gospel, Jesus came and said to the disciples, "Peace be with you," that statement speaks of the power of forgiveness. Jesus gave this great gift to the Apostle and their descendants. **But..... we are also commissioned to forgive others! Yes, you!!**

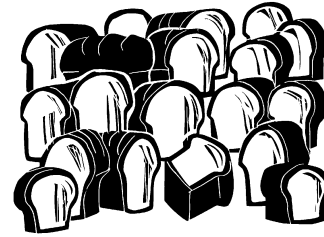

The-Shoe-That-Grows

Did you know that there are 300 million children in the world that do not have the basic foot protection that shoes provide? Kenton Lee found this out first hand when in 2007 he was doing some missionary work in Kenya. When he came back to the United States, he decided that he wanted to do something about that.

With the help of a former shoe designer for Nike, Kenton designed "The-Shoe-That-Grows." It is a sandal type shoe that can be adjusted to fit 5 different shoe sizes, and to last at least 5 years. That way as a child grows, the shoe can be adjusted to grow with them. They come in 3 sizes - Small (toddler size 10 to kid's/women's size 2, or EUR 27-33), Large (kid's/women size 1.5 to 7.5 or EUR 33 to 38), and Adult (women's 7/men's 6 to men's size 12 or EUR 38 to 45).

Mr. Lee formed a company, Because International, to help distribute the shoes. They sell the shoes here, for \$50/pair, but for each pair sold they donate two pairs to those in need. So you really are getting three pairs of shoes for \$50; one for yourself and two for those who are poor.

I bought a pair in January, and wore them during my vacation and I participated in Because International's annual fundraiser, "Wear-A-Pair." I wore my pair every day from April 3 to April 9 (at least part of the day). A fundraiser page was set up at: https://fundraise.theshoethatgrows.org/fundraiser/920416?is_new=true

The Divine Mercy Chaplet

The Lord said to Blessed Faustina:



"You will recite this chaplet on the beads of the Rosary in the following manner:"First of all, you will say one Our Father, one Hail Mary, and the, I Believe In God.

Then: On the Our Father Beads you will say the following words:

Eternal Father, I offer You the Body and Blood Soul and Divinity of Your dearly beloved Son, Our Lord Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.

On the Hail Mary Beads you will say the following words: For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

In conclusion ThreeTimes you will recite these words; Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world. (Diary, 476)

Our Lord said to Blessed Faustine:

Unceasingly recite this chaplet that I have taught you. Whoever will recite it will receive great mercy at the hour of death ... My infinite mercy (687) ... Oh, what great graces I will grant to souls who will recite this chaplet (848) ... Through the chaplet you will obtain anything, if what you ask for is compatible with My will (1731) ... I want the whole world to know My infinite mercy. I want to give unimaginable graces to those who trust in My mercy (687).



Powerful Prayer, read the story - very interesting.
