

## MINUTES OF HOLY NAME SOCIETY MEETING, SEPTEMBER 22, 2016

Angelo Cinti went over the schedule of events for the 2016-2017 fiscal year for the Society and distributed the Calendar of Events, Finance Sources, and Activities. Members are encouraged to keep these handy and participate in as many events as possible, as there are many opportunities for worthwhile services to the Parish and good fellowship. It was also suggested that the minutes of each meeting would be sent to inactive members. Angelo also talked about our level of activity in the parish, and Deacon Dan Meehan mentioned that it's Father J.C.'s wish that Holy Name Society Members become ushers at all of the Masses. Also, it should be a goal for the Society to recruit 5 new members, and we are planning to extend our membership to Corpus Christi and Good Shepherd Parishes.

It was also mentioned that Bill Janus was rushed to the hospital; prayers are requested for Bill and his family.

Meeting adjourned with the reading of the Holy Name Pledge.
