

**MINUTES OF HOLY NAME SOCIETY MEETING, OCTOBER 27, 2016**

The October 2016 Meeting of the Resurrection Parish Holy Name Society (hereinafter referred to as the “HNS” or “The Society”) was called to order by Angelo Cinti at 7:35 PM. The Holy Name Society Golden Arrow prayer was read, and the meeting began with the reading of the minutes from the September 22, 2016 meeting. Jon Branca made a motion to approve the minutes, seconded by Frank Balusek. The minutes of the 9/22/2016 meeting were approved. Hereafter, the minutes will continue to be posted on the Parish website.

Treasurer Joe Dunn read the Treasurers report, which will be included in the Minutes. Jon Branca made a motion to accept the Treasurer’s report as read and Ken Mortimer seconded. The Treasurer’s Report was unanimously approved.

It was agreed that The Society will receive communion as a group on October 29, 2016 at the 5:00 Mass.

A few changes were made to the yearly schedule previously circulated. The November, 2016 meeting will be moved to November 17<sup>th</sup>, as the 4<sup>th</sup> Thursday of November falls on Thanksgiving. Also, instead of meeting for breakfast at a separate location, the Society will reserve tables at the Bountiful Breakfast to be held on 11/6/2016 in the Parish Center. Also, The Society Members will attend the 10:00 Mass on 11/6/16.

The December Meeting of the Society will be held at 7:00 PM on December 15<sup>th</sup>, and dinner will be served.

Tom Lyons gave a presentation regarding our annual 50/50 Raffle. The drawing will be held on Sunday, November 20, 2016 after the 12:00 PM Mass. Tickets will be sold on the weekends of 11/5 and 11/6, 11/12 and 11/13, and 11/19 and 11/20. Tom asked that we please return our member-assigned tickets as soon as possible, and anyone who can’t sell their assigned tickets should return these to Tom so that they can be properly accounted for and included with the general ticket sales. Since Tom no longer lives close by, we need to be sure that we have adequate selling coverage at each Mass - at least two guys at each door. We also need to be

sure to write down the ticket numbers and amounts on the accounting sheet that Tom prepared.

There will be 5 prizes; 1<sup>st</sup> prize is 20%; 2<sup>nd</sup> prize is 15%, and the 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> prizes will each be 5%. When selling tickets, the buyer's address is not necessary – name and phone number will be fine.

Angelo Cinti provided additional information on the future Trenton Thunder Evening to be held on May 23, 2017. We are looking for a game against the Reading Phillies. We will also open ticket sales to Corpus Christi and Good Shepherd Parishes. Tickets will be \$30.00, and will include dinner.

We would like to extend membership in our Parish Holy Name Society to the men of Good Shepherd and Corpus Christi Parishes, and perhaps rotate the meeting locations among the three parishes. Also, each member should set a goal to recruit five new members to our HNS.

We need a committee to work on the HNS bylaws, as there are a few provisions that we may want to change.

There being no further business, John Branca motioned to adjourn the meeting, seconded by John Mayo. Meeting was adjourned at 8:30 PM, with the reading of the Holy Name Society Pledge.
